What can we expect from a Music Explorers safari?

Each term, we have a specific focus which we explore through songs, games, rhythm, and movement. Some of our focuses have been rhythm, pitch, the orchestra and singing! Your explorer will be equipped with a safari bag of instruments and resources upon enrolment to bring to class each week and enjoy at home!

Are Music Explorers classes like instrumental lessons?

Not at all and we love it that way! Music Explorers is specifically designed for pre-school aged children, between the ages of 3-5 years old, with their specific needs and interests in mind. We use song, movement, and fun activities to make sure that everyone is engaged and learning!

The concepts that we learn in Music Explorers, like rhythm and pitch, are the essential building blocks to music. Giving your child the opportunity to learn these skills in such a playful, engaging environment, is essentially giving them a head start if they choose to play an instrument in the future!
